INTERMENT OPTIONS IN THE CEMETERY

The Town of Whitecourt offers a number of choices from traditional burial or cremation interment, to Field of Honour Interment for our Veterans.

Grave Plots

- · One single burial per grave plot; and,
- Up to three cremated remains per plot.

Niches

Each Columbarium niche provides space for one or two cremated remains.

Field of Honour

A Veteran, as defined under the War Veterans Allowance Act, and immediate family members may be interred in the Field of Honour, provided the family member's cremated remains are interred in the same plot as the Veteran.

Interment may only take place after:


- The Certificate of Title and Sales Contract have been signed by the Cemetery Supervisor and the "Authorized Person" in control of the remains;
- The Burial Permit has been received by the Cemetery Supervisor; and,
- All applicable fees and charges have been paid.

All requests for interment shall be made by entering into a Cemetery Sales Contract for Cemetery Supplies and Cemetery Services with the Town of Whitecourt at least two business days between the months of May and October, and three business days from November to April, prior to the request time of interment (per Bylaw 1563 S.9.2).

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

Does the Town sell or supply headstones or memorial markers for grave plots?

No, these items must be purchased from a supplier. The Town must approve the headstone or marker prior to its delivery or installation in the Cemetery.

Does the Town sell or supply memorials for Columbarium niches?

Yes, the memorial for the Columbarium consists of the granite niche front which is included in the cost of the niche purchase.

What kind of flowers or other tributes are allowed at the Cemetery?

Cut flowers, wreaths, artificial flowers or other items may be placed on grave plots or in designated common areas for the Columbaria. These items will be removed after a period of time when they are deemed by the Cemetery Supervisor to be in poor condition or when they interfere with Cemetery maintenance.

Only cut or articifical flowers are allowed in niche vases. Optional niche vases must be purchased from the Town and installed by the Cemetery Supervisor.

The planting of shrubs, trees, bulbs or flowers is not allowed in the Cemetery, except by the Cemetery Supervisor.

What is Cemetery Spring Clean Up?

It is a clean up conducted annually in order to maintain the appearance of the Whitecourt Cemetery and ensure the safety of visitors and employees. This clean up includes: litter control, seeding and leveling of interment sites, and removal of non-approved items throughout the Cemetery (per the Cemetery Bylaw).

Can I add a planting near my loved one's plot?

Planting of trees, shrubs, or perenials is not permitted within the Cemetery. Only memorial items within affixed vases are allowed on grave plots. To ensure the safety and ability for staff to maintain the grounds, if items placed on grave plots or niche fronts become damaged or unsightly, these items may be removed at the Cemetery Supervisor's discretion.

COLUMBARIA

A columbarium is a resting place for cremated remains; it is a popular alternative to in-ground burials. Niches can hold up to two (2) standard sized urns. The two-sided columbaria, currently placed within the Whitecourt Cemetery, have 30 niches on each side. MONUMENTS

Monuments are structures within a cemetery placed or constructed on a grave plot or niche front for the purpose of memorialization. The Town does not supply or sell monuments for grave plots. Loved ones may order a monument through a funeral home or directly from a monument company.

Grave Plots:

- No more than two monuments are allowed on a single grave plot.
- The Cemetery Supervisor must approve the monument prior to its installation.
- Where two people are buried side by side, a single monument commemorating both individuals is allowed, if set midway between the two grave lots.
- Grave covers are not permitted.

Niche Fronts

The purchase of a niche within a columbarium includes the supply of one (1) granite niche front.

- Inscriptions must be a Modified Roman font, and contain: surname; given name(s); year of birth; year of death.
- Double inscriptions shall be allowed with double inurnments.
